



Care of Books

- O Before Your Child Enters School, He Or She Should Be Able To: **Handle books appropriately**.
- To Help Your Child Be Ready for Kindergarten, You Can:

Read books, often, with your child so he/she will begin to understand book handling and print concepts (Print is read from left to right, return sweep, tracking, etc.).

Care of Books

To encourage personal responsibility, please help your child to:

- Establish a special shelf for library books
- O Bring books back on his or her book exchange day
- O Keep food and drinks away from books
- Protect books from pets
- O Keep water away from books
- O Bring books to and from school in a 2 gallon freezer bag to keep protected in backpack.
