Parenting	<p>Topic: Going over the home visits, ILA events, & Parenting classes</p> <p>Lesson: From now until the end of February, the parenting class will be covered by Paula Gajewski.</p>
Media	<p>Topic: Basic Computer terms knowledge; writing directions in English</p> <p>Lesson: Introduce Prezi presentation loaded at http://familylibrarymediacenter.weebly.com/for-esl-parents.html Use Smartboard to model function of presentation program to introduce and review Set 1 computer terms. Students practice reading the word, saying it and recalling it. Students then use workstations to show their understanding by naming each computer part or pointing to it on the screen.</p> <p>Whole group writing directions: One student models writing step-by-step directions in English (via document camera) about how to log in to G-Mail accounts. Group collectively brainstorms and offers suggestions while writing their own directions. Instructor follows directions agreed upon by group in order to test accuracy.</p>
